WARNING: Exercise caution and use reasonable supervision when appliance is used near children to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.


- This appliance is not intended for use by persons (including children) with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge.

- · Pack away in a dry place in the original carton when not in use.






Assembling the fan

Fan Body & Motor


 Place the base on the floor and remove the 4 screws, base spring washers and washers, leaving the centre screw.




Align the holes at the bottom of the outer tube to the holes in the base and re-insert first the washers, the base spring washers and then the screws, screwing until tight.



Loosen the height adjustment knob and pull the inner tube out to the desired height and re-tighten.



4. Loosen the neck screws on the motor neck and slide it over the inner tube, aligning one of the screws to the hole and re-tighten.






Blade & Grilles

 Unscrew the 4 rear grille locking screws and spring washers from the motor and assemble the rear grille, ensuring the handle is at the top.

NOTE: Tighten the screws to avoid vibration noise.




2. Remove the plastic cover from the motor shaft to insert the fan blade. Align the screw on the fan blade, to the flat area on the motor shaft. Tighten the blade screw.




3. Loosen the grille locking screw on the grille ring and place around the rear grille. Then position the front grille into the grille ring until it fits around both grilles.





NOTE: Ensure the grille locking ring is at the bottom.

4. Tighten the grille locking screw and nut on the bottom of the grille ring and add the grille ring cover.



The fan assembly is now complete.


Operating the fan

To operate the fan, turn the on/off/speed control dial.

Oscillate


Oscillation range of 85°.

Set the oscillating switch to the "I" position to oscillate, and the "O" position to stop.




Adjustments: Height Adjustment

Height can be adjusted by loosening and tightening the height adjustment knob and moving the motor head to the desired height.



Adjustments: Vertical Tilt Adjustment

Grip the top and bottom of the grille firmly and tilt to the desired position. If too difficult, loosen the centre bolt slightly to give more flexibility and re-tighten.





WARRANTY
